2012 SPRING CLEAN UP COLLECTION

Requirements: Ripon Residents ONLY ~ **NO Businesses**
Maximum Size of Pile 5'x 5' x 12' (300 cu. ft.)
One-Time Pick up Service

The intent of this program is to offer Ripon residents an opportunity to dispose of **LARGE** items that are unable to fit in the refuse can. Your household acceptable items must be placed on the street by curbside away from any refuse cans, fire hydrants, and vehicles. **The city will be split in two sections with Hwy 99 serving as the divider.**

If you live on the:

WEST side of Hwy 99 put items out between:

May 3rd – May 6th

If you live on the:

EAST side of Hwy 99 put items out between:

May 10th – May 13th

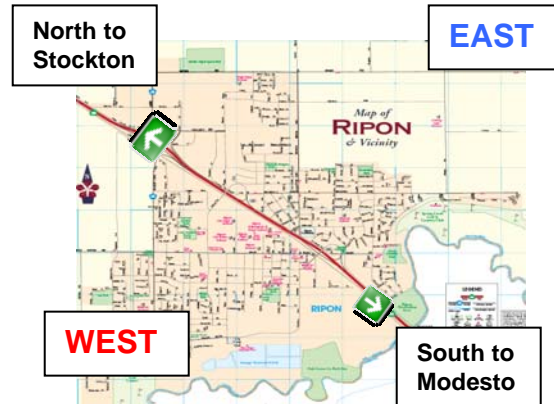
If you live in the following Homeowner's Association

This is a one-time service. Items put out after the scheduled dates will not be picked up.

Acceptable Items

BBQ's / Patio Furniture
Bicycles
Car / pickup tires - (Tires **MUST** be separated rims)
Carpet Remnants (**NO** larger than 5' X 5')
Couches / Sofas
Dishwashers / Microwaves
Doors
Dressers / Mattresses
Fire Extinguishers (non-pressurized)
Lawn Mowers (Gas & oil **MUST** be drained)
Scrap Metal
Stoves / Ovens
Tables / Chairs
Televisions / Computer Monitors (limit 3 per household)
Toilet / sinks / tubs
Vehicle Rims
Washers / Dryers
Water Softeners
Water Heaters

Unacceptable Items

No Refrigerators / Freezer
No Air Conditioning Unit
No Bags of loose trash
No Glass Items / Mirrors (i.e., shower doors)
No Hot Tubs / Spas
No Loose Trash / Yard Trimmings
No Tree Stumps, Dirt, Sod
No Dead Animals
No Commercial Business Material
No Construction / Demolition Material
No Batteries (see back page for drop-off sites)
No Truck or Tractor Tires
No Large Automobile Parts or batteries
No Household Hazardous Waste *
No Paint *
No Chemicals or any types of liquid *
No Concrete / Asphalt / Lumber
No Cardboard, Newspaper
No Florescent Light Bulbs *

All metal items for recycling such as appliances, lawn mowers, etc. must be separated from all other items.

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS LEFT IN THE STREET WILL BE TAGGED AND LEFT FOR YOUR DISPOSAL. YOU WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING REMAINING DEBRIS.



RIPON RECYCLING PROGRAM

City of Ripon ~Public Works Department ~ 599-2151

To encourage recycling the City of Ripon has provided a recycling program to Ripon residents within the city limits. The recycling program is a public/private partnership between the Ripon School Parent Faculty, American Recycling Company, and the City of Ripon to provide local recycling of newspaper, cardboard, mixed paper, aluminum cans, plastic beverage containers, glass bottles, Styrofoam, and electronic waste.

California Redemption Value (CRV) earned from this program benefit the Parent/Faculty Clubs for the children in Ripon schools.

LOCATION: Ripon Park & Ride Lot (old Nestle's parking lot) 178 Industrial Avenue. Collection hours for aluminum cans, plastic, glass beverage containers & electronic waste are on Saturdays between 8:00 am to 2:00 pm. Volunteers from the Parent/Faculty Clubs will available to provide assistance.

ELECTRONIC WASTE: E-waste may be dropped off during collection hours. Items include televisions (all sizes), radios, copiers, phones, computers, monitors & printers.

HOUSEHOLD BATTERY DROP-OFF SITES: Drop-off boxes for household batteries including lithium and cell phone batteries are located at City Hall, the Police Department, the Library, and the Senior Center.

MOTOR OIL & FILTER: Kragen (O'Reilly) Auto Parts will take up to 5 gallons of motor oil per person.

PAINT: Latex base paint in the original can & label may be dropped off at Ace Hardware. (5 gal limit)
