The Spring Clean Up Program has Changed

We are no longer picking up unwanted items the 1st two weeks of May



The City of Ripon is now offering a **LARGE UNWANTED ITEM PICK UP PROGRAM**

Residents are now able to schedule a pick up of large unwanted items between the months of April through September. To dispose of items through this program:

- Call or e-mail the Public Works Department to schedule a pick up day—see contact information above.
- You will be provided a written confirmation of your scheduled pick up day.
- Place your unwanted item(s) on the curb by 7:00 am on the scheduled pick up day, but no earlier than the day before.

Large Unwanted Item Pick up Program Rules:

- Each residential utility customer may schedule one pick up per year.
- Only acceptable items (see list on back) will be picked up.
- Limit of 4 large items per customer.
- Items must be placed on the curb in a manner that does not obstruct the path of travel of vehicles and pedestrians.
- Only items of customers with a confirmation number will be picked up.



CITY OF RIPON LARGE UNWANTED ITEM PROGRAM

Acceptable Items

BBQ
Patio furniture
Bicycles
Furniture
Carpet remnants (no larger than 5'x5')
Dishwashers
Washers / dryers
Doors (no glass)
Mattresses / box springs
Fire extinguishers (non-pressurized)
Lawn mowers (gas & oil MUST be drained)
Scrap metal
Exercise equipment
Stoves / ovens
Toilets / sinks / tubs
Vehicle rims (tires must be removed)
Water heaters
Water softeners (salt removed)

Unacceptable Items

Refrigerators / freezers
Air conditioning units
Bags of loose trash
Yard waste / dirt / sod / rocks
Glass items / mirrors
Hot tubs / spas
Commercial business material
Batteries of any kind
Vehicle parts
Paint / motor oil
Any type of liquids
Concrete / asphalt / lumber
Cardboard / newspaper
Fluorescent light bulbs
Tires
Electronic waste
Microwaves / televisions / computers
Construction material
