

*Carrum Health is a special surgery benefit for active employees, early retirees (pre-Medicare), COBRA participants, and dependents who are enrolled in eligible PRISM Anthem or Blue Shield medical plans (where PRISM is the program administrator that your employer contracts with for healthcare benefits). With the exception of second opinions, due to IRS rules, members on a high-deductible plan must pay their deductible, but coinsurance and copays are waived. The second-opinion service is free, and most will be done virtually. Per IRS rules, a portion of any covered travel expenses will be reported as taxable income. County of San Luis Obispo only: For knee and hip replacements, spinal fusion, and bariatric weight-loss procedures, you need to receive an expert second opinion through Carrum Health prior to scheduling your procedure. If surgery is the right treatment path, you may continue through Carrum or get your procedure done through another provider.
