

RESOLUTION NO. 21-60

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIPON APPROVING VSP-SUNLIFE VISION INSURANCE, INSTEAD OF MES VISION INSURANCE, TO BE PROVIDED TO ALL EMPLOYEES AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS IN CALENDAR YEAR 2022

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ripon passed Resolution 21-51 on October 12, 2021, which adopted an increase in the cost of health and welfare benefits to be provided to all employees and City Council Members in calendar year 2022; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 21-51 summarized the health and welfare plans to be provided for calendar year 2022 as the following:

- Kaiser Healthcare
- CSAC Blue Shield Healthcare
- Sunlife Dental
- MES Vision
- Sunlife Life Insurance
- Sunlife Long-term Disability

WHEREAS, changes to MES Vision are on the horizon for January 2022, which were unbeknownst to the City at the time of the approval of Resolution 21-51; and

WHEREAS, VSP-Sunlife Vision insurance can be purchased for the same premium, which would not change the approved premium costs to the employees for family coverage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Ripon approves VSP-Sunlife Vision insurance for calendar year 2022, which will not have any additional costs to the City or the Employee; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the following summarized the health and welfare plans to be provided for calendar year 2022 as the following:

- Kaiser Healthcare
- CSAC Blue Shield Healthcare
- Sunlife Dental
- VSP-Sunlife Vision
- Sunlife Life Insurance
- Sunlife Long-term Disability
