RPOA Memorandum of Understanding

AMENDMENT #2 TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2020

BETWEEN THE CITY OF RIPON AND RIPON POLICE OFFICERS' ASSOCIATION

On July 10, 2018, the City Council of the City of Ripon adopted Resolution No. 18-57, approving the 2018-2020 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). The adjustments to wages, hours and conditions of employment that are set forth in this Amendment have been discussed by and between the bargaining representatives of the City of Ripon (hereinafter, "City") and the bargaining representatives of the Ripon Police Officers Association (hereinafter, "Association") and shall apply to all employees of the City working in the classifications of Patrol Officer.

The City and the Association agree as follows:

ARTICLE VI - SALARIES, Section K and L are hereby added to read in full as follows:

K. Effective the first full pay period in July 2020, the Patrol Officer Level 206 shall be increased to 207.5 for all employees of the City working in the classification of Patrol Officer on the approval date of this amendment.

L. In March 2021, all employees of the City working in the classification of Patrol Officer on the approval date of this amendment shall receive an off-schedule one-time payment equal to 1.2 percent of the employee's annual salary as referenced above in Article VI Section K. This off-schedule one-time payment will have no bearings on any future salary negotiations.

Except as amended herein, the 2018-2020 MOU and each term and condition contained therein shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.
